Then one dark day her daddy was hit by a train and killed. Patsy was left to fend for her brothers and sisters until County Welfare carted them all off to an orphanage in nearby COWPOKE COUNTY.

Patsy was forced to work like a slave day and night. She had no shoes and her only dress was in rags.

At the tender age of fourteen the determined Patsy decided to escape the godforsaken hellhole that was swallowing up her young life and late one night she jumped the orphanage fence and hitched a ride on a freight train heading towards Nashville.

She made up a song about her life right there and then called 'THE BALLAD OF PATSY D' and the rest is history.

On arriving in Nashville, she entered herself in a local talent quest where she got up and sang her life story to an attentive crowd. Everybody broke down and cried and Patsy became a star!

Since those early days Patsy has established herself as the most successful 'QUEEN OF COUNTRY CORN' Nashville has ever produced having won the title three years in a row.

In the wake of her success she has accumulated a number of fabulous dresses and is renowned for her incredible shoe collection throughout the whole U.S.A.

Patsy has sung her way around the world with hits like 'ONE HORSE TOWN', 'DON'T FALL IN LOVE WITH A COWBOY', and of course her favourite, 'THE BALLAD OF PATSY D.'

Patsy DeCline – The Queen of Country Corn is the alter ego of well known Adelaide actor, singer, songwriter and designer **Kerry Reid**.

As 'Patsy' she has entertained audiences at the 1995 Vitalstatistix Cabaret Season in Adelaide, the 1996 Melbourne Fringe Festival, the 1997 Melbourne Comedy Festival, the 1999 Bakehouse Cabaret Season in Adelaide and Sunday Salon at the Adelaide Festival Centre in 1999.

Kerry resides in Adelaide, South Australia and has performed with Fools Co., On The Beach Theatre Co., Patch Theatre, Adelaide Performing Theatre, Oddbodies Theatre, Stir Theatre, Children's Champion Productions and Vitalstatistix Theatre Company in "Titbits" the award winning cabaret comedy about breasts and breast cancer which toured extensively throughout Australia from 1997 to 2003.

Her cabaret career extends back to the mid 1980s when she was a member of the comedy duo "Dino Valentino and Sandra Lee in Club Italiano" with stand-up comic Bruno Lucia performing in both Adelaide and Melbourne and of female trio "The Freud Sisters" in a successful season of "Animals, Angels and Regular Guys" at the 1988 Adelaide Fringe Festival.

She is currently performing as "Miss Kitty" in 6 piece Gypsy Jazz outfit "Miss Kitty's Karavan" which debuted at the 2012 Adelaide Fringe in "The Wrong Place at the Right Time".
